Plan Details

Welcome to Benemax[®]. The Benemax Health Plan[®] integrates a fully insured component (BCBSMA) and a self-funded component (128 Technology, Inc.) into a single benefit package. Your BCBSMA coverage includes a \$2,000 in-network deductible per individual/\$4,000 family maximum per plan year. 128 Technology, Inc., via Benemax, pays this plan deductible in full on your behalf. Once the plan deductible is satisfied, 128 Technology, Inc. also pays the in-network co-insurance in full on your behalf.

Below is a brief reference of frequently used in-network services and your final cost after your claims have been processed by both BCBS and Benemax.



<u>**Out-of-Network:**</u> If you use out-of-network providers, office visits are subject to a \$25 copay for the first *\$2,000/ \$4,000. After this out-of-network deductible is satisfied, members are responsible for 20- 40% out-of-network co-insurance. Members are also responsible for charges considered over usual and customary.



How Your Health Plan Works

The chart below will help you understand who pays for what and when.



Your Family visits your provider (doctor/hospital) and shows both their BCBS ID card and their Benemax Card.

Your Doctor or Provider will bill BCBS.

BCBS will process your claim, notify your provider, and send a Claims Summary to you and your provider.

Benemax receives a report of your claims from BCBS. Benemax reviews your claim and makes additional payments on behalf of your employer.

Benemax notifies you of payment via a Benemax Explanation of Benefits (EOB). You are responsible to pay the amount due to your provider as shown on the Benemax EOB.
